Integrated Management System (IMS) Policy

Egyptian Nuclear and Radiological Regulatory Authority (ENRRA) is an independent authority that carries out all regulatory and control functions related to the nuclear and radiological activities in Egypt. Its main objective is to protect the human, property, and the environment from the risks of exposure to ionizing radiation.

ENRRA practices its activities based on the priority of safety without being influenced by economic, political, financial, or any other aspects.

ENRRA performs its regulatory oversight and administrative activities based on an Integrated Management System (IMS), which complies with the applicable Egyptian laws and the highest applicable standards of safety, security, health, environment, quality and project management.

During conducting its mission ENRRA is committed to:

- Establishing, reviewing periodically, and updating of S.M.A.R.T IMS objectives at ENRRA's functions, levels and processes needed for the IMS.
- Providing competent resources required, ensuring safe and healthy work conditions for ENRRA's employees and enhancing of qualifications, knowledge and competencies of the employees.
- Maintaining and developing a high level of safety culture among ENRRA's employees.
- Full compliance to the requirements of the legislations of the Arab Republic of Egypt, regulatory rules and guides in the field of atomic energy use, as well as quality management system (QMS), environmental management system (EMS), occupational health and safety management system (OH&S MS);
- Controlling of OH&S risks, eliminating hazards to protect environment, including prevention of contamination, as well as the rational use of resources.
- Ensuring the implementation; and continuously improvement of the IMS and Involvement of all ENRRA employees into the enhancement of it.
- Using a graded approach, in accordance with the performance of regulatory functions.
- Establishing effective interaction and consultation with interested parties through a transparent and open communication process with the protection of the confidentiality of information;
- Communicating IMS Policy to all ENRRA employees and ensuring it is understood, implemented in practice, and communicated with interested parties.
- Analyzing periodically the IMS policy during the management review meetings to ensure its relevance and applicable.

ENRRA's top management undertakes the implementation of this policy and will exert all needed effort to fulfill the obligations taken.
